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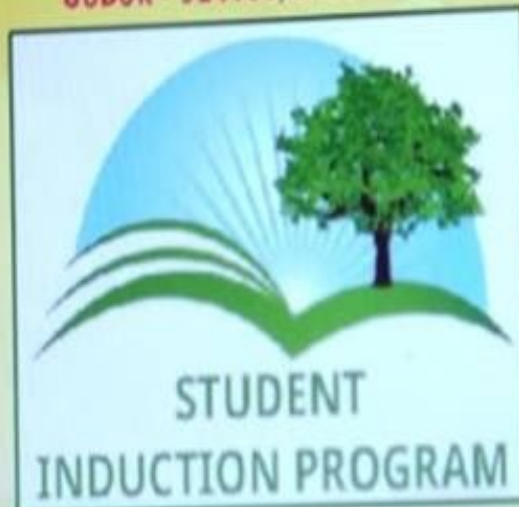

### **Need of the Programme**

A student induction programme is conceived along the guidelines suggested by the UGC in its “A guide to student induction programme” following the UGC quality mandate dated 04-06-2020.

### **Objective of the Programme:**

**Governing** : Rules and regulations student support etc...

**Experiencing:** Subject Lecture , Study skills small group activities, physical activity creative and performing arts, Literary activities, universal human values etc...

**List of Activities to be Included are:**

**Physical Activity:** Regular physical activity with yogasana and sports each student should pick one game and learn it for the duration of the induction programme , and she may continue with it later also

**Mentoring:** Each teacher has allotted 20-30 students and this will continue up to their (Student) programme is completed in the college. These mentor groups meet periodically once in 15 days / whenever necessary from the first semester to the end of the programme. It gets the student to explore one self and allows one to experience the joy of learning, stand up to peer pressure, take decisions with courage, be aware of relationships, be sensitive to others, understand the role money in life and feeling of prosperity etc. Focus should be on inculcating values of equality and responsibility towards once fellow citizens of nation. Mentoring must not be through do's and don'ts but by getting students to explore and think by engaging them in dialogue.

Mentor mentee relationship can help students form a bond with faculty members which can be it great help during various tough times in courses
